

LSPC16 Speaker: Aicha Diakite



Aicha Diakite studied Electrical Engineering at the Technical University of Berlin, Germany and Poznan University of Technology, Poland. She went on to study Architecture and Industrial Design at the National Autonomous University of Mexico, where she received a Postgraduate Architectural Lighting Design Diploma in 2011.

In 2013 she finished her master's studies in the Department of Lighting Technology at the Technical University of Berlin, with a thesis on "Urban lighting design: Determination of quality criteria and performance requirements for lighting master plans". Aicha's thesis was awarded the H.-J. Hellwig Prize 2014 by the German Lighting Technology Association, the Hans-Peter Willumeit Award by the Foundation Committee of the Center of Human-Machine Systems (ZMMS) and the Clara von Simson Prize honoring women in Science and Technology by the Technische Universität Berlin.

She is currently working in the Faculty of Lighting Technology at the Technical University of Berlin, having previously worked for Lightteam Gustavo Aviles, Mexico City, Kardorff Ingenieure Lichtplanung, Berlin, OSRAM, Berlin and Hellux Konstruktions-Licht, Berlin.
