Dwayne Waggoner completed his Bachelor of Science degree in Engineering Technology at California Polytechnic State University, San Luis Obispo, USA in 2008.

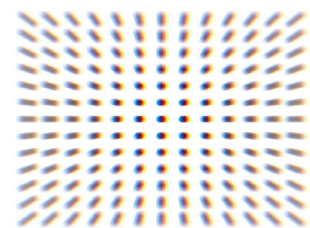
